TV Licence Enforcement: What Are the Rights of Homeowners?

A recent viral video showing a woman refusing entry to a TV Licensing officer has reignited public debate over the powers of TV licence inspectors and the legal rights of homeowners. The incident, which has garnered significant attention across social media platforms, underscores the need for clarity on what authority these officers hold and how homeowners can legally respond. Enforcement reporter Sarhan Basem from <u>Brussels Morning</u> explains it all.

What Are the Powers of TV Licence Inspectors?

Under UK law, TV Licensing officers are tasked with ensuring that residents are paying the appropriate licence fee if they watch or record live TV broadcasts or use BBC iPlayer. However, the powers of these officers are more limited than many might assume.

Key points to note include:

No Automatic Right of Entry: TV Licensing officers do not have an automatic right to enter private property. They can only request entry and may visit to assess whether a TV licence is needed.

Search Warrants Required: If an officer suspects a breach of licence law but is refused entry, they must obtain a court-issued search warrant to legally enter a home. Without this, homeowners are not obligated to let them in.

Privacy Rights: As a resident, you are within your rights to refuse entry to TV Licensing officers if they do not present a search warrant. Homeowners should understand that forcing entry without a valid warrant is a breach of privacy and could lead to legal action.

Consequences of Non-Compliance

While TV Licensing officers are limited in their powers without a warrant, non-compliance with TV licensing regulations can still lead to serious consequences. If a resident is found to be using television services illegally (without the required licence), they may face:

- A fine of up to £1,000
- Possible court prosecution

It is vital that UK residents understand their obligations to pay the TV licence if required by law. However, residents should also be aware of their rights when approached by TV Licensing officers, particularly regarding entry into their homes.

Ensuring Compliance and Protection

Sarhan Basem from Brussels Morning emphasises "While it's essential to comply with TV licensing laws, homeowners must understand that TV Licensing officers do not have an automatic right of entry. If a resident feels uncomfortable or unsure, they are under no obligation to let anyone into their home unless presented with a valid search warrant."

Toyota Rav4 Hybrid

EOPLE are willing to wait months, even years for a Toyota RAV4 Hybrid, especially Cruiser spec.

Is it worth the wait? This mid-sized SUV offers a lot of positive traits, terrific real-world efficiency, and it's a very good size: offering plenty of practicality for growing families.

Performance/drive

The RAV4 does it right for families who are after a predictable, comfortable, and even enjoyable SUV to live with – it nails the brief.

The hybrid powertrain is powerful enough (even with five onboard) and has some serious smarts when it comes to choosing whether to run in EV mode, use the petrol engine, or use a combination of the two.

It will often flick to EV when you're coasting around town, or even use battery power to pull you away from a standstill. And there's also the chance you will find the car running electric (there's a green indicator on the screen to prove it) when you're driving on the highway, using light throttle.

The driving manners of the RAV4 are really good too, with sweet, natural feeling steering that is well weighted and easy to judge for parking moves or at pace. It also has lane-keeping assistance system for highway driving

The suspension also deals really well with lumpy roads and sharp edges too. It's definitely comfortable as a family car, and as a commuter.

The interior

New to the recently-updated RAV4 is the addition of a larger touchscreen media system, making the interior feel a touch more modern in the higherspec versions. The JBL sound system is pretty good too, especially as it includes built-in sat nav. There's also a new digital instrument cluster in this spec. It is crisp, colourful and more modern than the previous version. It's easy to use and the info on display is useful and manageable in terms of moving through the menus using the steering wheel controls.



In fact it's the controls that make the RAV4 simple to live with, as none of the crucial stuff is buried in the media screen. There's a pair of big rubberised dials for climate control, while fan and air-conditioning controls all fall easily to hand too. Plus, in this spec, you get the heated and ventilated (cooled) seat buttons in that same area as well.

Double bean and roasted pepper chilli

This warming vegetarian chilli is a low-fat, healthy option that packs in the veggies and flavour. Serve with Tabasco sauce, sour cream or yoghurt.

Ingredients

- 2 onions chopped
- 2 celery sticks- finely chopped
- 2 yellow or orange peppers- finely chopped
- 2 tbsp sunflower oil or rapeseed oil
- 2 x 460g jars roasted red peppers
- 2 tsp chipotle paste
- 2 tbsp red wine vinegar
- 1 tbsp cocoa powder
- 1 tbsp dried oregano
- 1 tbsp sweet smoked paprika
- 2 tbsp ground cumin
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 2 x 400g cans chopped tomatoes
- 400g can refried beans
- 3 x 400g cans kidney beans drained and rinsed
- 2 x 400g cans black beans drained and rinsed

Method

Put the onions, celery and chopped peppers with the oil in your largest flameproof casserole dish or heavybased saucepan, and fry gently over a low heat until soft but not coloured.

2 Drain both jars of peppers over a bowl to catch the juices. Put a quarter of the peppers into a food processor with the chipotle paste, vinegar, cocoa, dried spices and herbs. Whizz to a purée, then stir into the softened veg and cook for a few mins.

3 Add the tomatoes and refried beans with 1 can water and the reserved pepper juice. Simmer for 1 hr until thickened, smoky and the tomato chunks have broken down to a smoother sauce.

4 At this stage you can cool and chill the sauce if making ahead. Otherwise add the kidney and black beans, and the remaining roasted peppers, cut into bite-sized pieces, then reheat. (This makes a large batch, so once the sauce is ready it might be easier to split it between two pans when you add the beans and peppers.) Once bubbling and the beans are hot, season to taste and serve.

It happened this month...

2021 Pro-Trump mob lays siege to White House

On January 6 in Washington, D.C., thousands attended a 'Save America Rally' near the White House. There, President Donald Trump and others addressed the crowd to express opposition to the certification of the Electoral College results of the 2020 presidential election which would finalise Joe Biden as the victor.

Events escalated when several hundred left the rally and advanced toward the United States Capitol building. They breached security perimeters and entered building, thereby disrupting the joint session of Congress convened to certify the election results. property and violent confrontations with law enforcement, resulting in numerous injuries to police and civilians, overall including five fatalities.

The unprecedented breach led to a lockdown of the Capitol and the deployment of the National Guard and other law enforcement agencies to restore order.

In the aftermath, numerous individuals were arrested and charged for their roles in the events. The House of Representatives impeached President Trump for the second time on January 13, charging him with "Incitement of Insurrection," though he was later acquitted by the Senate.



Bloody Sunday in Belfast

On January 30 in Londonderry, Northern Ireland, 13 unarmed civil rights demonstrators were shot dead by British Army paratroopers in an event that becomes known as "Bloody Sunday."

The protesters, all Northern Catholics, were marching in protest of the British policy of internment of suspected Irish nationalists. British authorities had ordered the march banned, and sent troops to confront the demonstrators when it went ahead. The soldiers fired indiscriminately into the crowd of protesters, killing 13 and wounding 17.

The killings brought worldwide attention to the crisis in Northern Ireland and sparked protests all across Ireland. In Dublin, the capital of independent Ireland, outraged Irish citizens lit the British embassy aflame on February 2.

In April 1972, the British government released a report exonerating British troops from any illegal actions during the Londonderry protest. Irish indignation over Britain's Northern Ireland policies grew, and Britain increased its military presence in the North while removing any vestige of Northern self-rule.

Zante

Greece's third-largest Ionian island offers has the most all-inclusive resorts and hotels, all on the busiest side of the island. The energetic town of **Laganas** draws revellers from across the continent and, although it's only minutes away, the peaceful town of **Agios Sostis** is worlds apart from its lively neighbour. You can spend long days relaxing on pristine beaches lined with fragrant pine trees.

Wildlife lovers may want to head to **Kalamaki**, where you might be lucky enough to spot endangered sea turtles.

Tunisia

If you're looking for adventure, the rolling sand dunes of the Sahara Desert are within easy reach, and you can explore this seemingly endless landscape by quad bike, 4×4 or even camel. While there are whitewashed villages and ancient ruins to discover, it's the modern coastal resorts where you'll find the best all-inclusive options.

Sousse is one of the most popular resorts, and the 10km stretch of gleaming sand is ideal for relaxing. There's plenty of history here too, and you can lose yourself in the maze-like streets of the old medina. Port El Kantaoui, just 10 minutes up the road, is a more glamorous base, with its yacht-filled marina. While the driver's seat comfort and adjustment is good, taller people might find the passenger seat to be too high, though it does offer eightway power adjustment.

Storage is excellent in the RAV4 with the big shelf in front of the passenger offering a good space for stuff. There are also good nooks near the gear selector (including a 50-cent-piecesized section which is apparently great for putting your garage or gate fob), and there are big cup holders as well as a covered centre console bin. Front occupants also get large door pockets with bottle holders.

The rear seat accommodation easily has enough space for a 6'0" adult and there's a decent amount of width to the seat as well, so three adults across is possible. that setup or 542L with the floor at standard height). Fold the rear seats down, and there's 1690L of capacity.

Under the bonnet

2WD Hybrid models pair a 2.5-litre naturally aspirated petrol engine with an electric motor and small battery pack, for a system output of 160kW

Running costs

All Toyota models come with a fiveyear, unlimited-kilometre warranty, but if you make sure you maintain logbook servicing (with Toyota or other approved mechanics) you can get up to seven years of powertrain cover.

Headroom is generous, knee room good, and toe room fine.

If you have younger occupants there are ISOFIX points in the window seats, three top-tether points and directional air-vents and USB charging to keep those in the back happy. Plus, there is a storage pocket (just one), flip-down arm-rest with cupholders and bottle holders in the doors.

The boot is another plus, with 580 litres of cargo capacity. There's easily enough space for a family to head away for a weekend in the RAV4. Even if you've got two children, two dogs and a bootfull of stuff, the car can handle it.

There's a space-saver spare wheel in this grade, and an adjustable boot floor to allow just a wee bit more depth to the space (it's 580L in Choose the AWD model and you get an additional 'eFour' electric motor at the rear axle, and power bumps to 163kW.

However, if you don't want to wait months (years, possibly) for a RAV4 Hybrid, there's also a betterthan-average 2.0-litre four-cylinder petrol engine (127kW/203Nm) with a CVT auto and front-wheel drive. It's a pretty good urban runner, and has decent real-world efficiency on it side too. Maximum towing capacity is 480kg in 2WD Hybrid models. If you service under Toyota's Hybrid powertrain protocols, petrol-electric models will also have a health-check every 12 months, which will warranty cover the battery pack for up to 10 years. Service intervals are 12 months/15,000km.

Verdict

If you can wait, it's totally worth it. The Toyota RAV4, particularly in Cruiser Hybrid spec, makes a lot of sense for buyers who want an efficient, well-packaged, comfortable and likeable family SUV.

Iron deficiency anaemia Causes, symptoms and treatment

RON deficiency anaemia headache

is a condition where a lack of iron in the body leads to a reduction in the number of red blood cells.

Iron is used to produce red blood cells, which help store and carry oxygen in the blood. If you have fewer red blood cells than is normal, your organs and tissues won't get as much oxygen as they usually would.

There are several different types of anaemia, and each one has a different cause. Iron deficiency anaemia is the most common type.

Symptoms

Many people with iron deficiency anaemia only have a few symptoms. The severity of the symptoms largely depends on how quickly anaemia develops.

You may notice symptoms immediately, or they may develop gradually if your anaemia is caused by a long-term problem, such as a stomach ulcer.

The most common symptoms include:

- tiredness and lack of energy
- (letharav)
- shortness of breath
- noticeable heartbeats (heart palpitations)
- a pale complexion

Less common symptoms include:

- hearing sounds that come from inside the body, rather than from an outside source (tinnitus)
- an altered sense of taste
- feeling itchy
- hair loss
- a desire to eat non-food items, such as ice, paper or clav
- difficulty swallowing (dysphagia)
- painful open sores (ulcers) on the corners of your mouth
- spoon-shaped nails

When to see your GP

See your GP if you experience symptoms of iron deficiency anaemia. They should be able to diagnose the condition using a simple blood test.

What causes iron deficiency anaemia?

In men and post-menopausal women. the most common cause is bleeding in the stomach and intestines.

Unless you're pregnant, it's rare for iron deficiency anaemia to be caused just by a lack of iron in your diet. However, if you do lack dietary iron, it may mean vou're more likely to develop anaemia.

Treatment

Treatment for iron deficiency anaemia involves taking iron supplements to

boost the low levels of iron in your body. This is usually effective, and the condition rarely causes long-term problems.

You'll need to be monitored every few months to check the treatment is working and your iron levels have returned to normal.

Good sources of iron include:

- dark-green leafy vegetables, such as watercress and curly kale
- iron-fortified cereals or bread
- brown rice
- pulses and beans
- nuts and seeds
- meat, fish and tofu
- eaas
- dried fruit, such as dried apricots. prunes and raisins

Further problems

If iron deficiency anaemia is left untreated, it can make you more susceptible to illness and infection, as a lack of iron affects the body's immune system).

Severe iron deficiency anaemia may increase your risk of developing complications that affect the heart or lungs, such as an abnormally fast heartbeat (tachycardia) or heart failure, where your heart is unable to pump enough blood around your body at the right pressure.

The pros and cons of listening to music while working out

OMBINING music and workouts has become a common practice among fitness enthusiasts.

They can provide a boost of motivation and energy for when you're testing your one-rep max or just taking a brisk walk outdoors. Here we discuss the potential advantages and drawbacks of listening to music during a workout/ and, hopefully, it will make you think about how music (or no music) plays a role in your training.

Pros

Improved athletic performance

Music can help get you through some of your toughest workouts by improving your endurance and mentality and reducing perceived exertion. Finding the right music that fits with the intensity and tempo you plan to conquer will increase your chances of completing the exercise.

Mood booster/motivation

There's nothing wrong with listening to your favourite workout tunes to boost your mood for a successful run or walk. In fact, listening to your favourite songs or playlist will improve your mentality going into the workout by boosting both your motivation and confidence.

Decreased chance of fatigue

Listening to music improves your physical and mental endurance. Essentially, with music, you'll most likely be able to lift more, run faster, and work harder. For example, say you're doing a tempo run at a steady but challenging pace. Finding a playlist that matches your pace or cadence (steps per minute) will help you keep that mental toughness and complete the run.

Cons

Dependency

For some athletes (powerlifters, for example), listening to music may be beneficial for successfully completing the weight. However, if those athletes are training for a specific powerlifting meet that doesn't allow the use of personal music or playlists, those athletes will most likely have a disadvantage. On the other hand a runner who competing in a half marathon is able to use and rely on music to get them to the finish line. Overall, it depends on what you're training for.

Decreased athletic performance

For an Olympic lifter, powerlifter or endurance athlete (runner, cyclist, etc.), music can be used without significantly disrupting their athletic performance. However, for a gymnast or athlete training in calisthenics, listening to fast-paced and upbeat music wouldn't be ideal since their training relies on coordination, stability, focus and balance.

Distraction

Music, especially if it's immersive, can divert your attention from maintaining proper form or technique. It can also have an impact on safety as you may be less aware of hazards such as traffic when running ouytdoors.

Overall boredom

Music may not always be sufficient to combat boredom or monotony during long workout sessions. Music alone might not provide the variety and mental engagement needed to stay motivated over time. It's important to incorporate a mix of exercise routines and seek other sources of motivation to keep your workouts interesting.

The bottom line

Listening to music while working out can have numerous benefits; however, it's crucial to be mindful of potential safety concerns and avoid dependency on music. Finding a balance that suits your preferences, exercise goals and safety considerations is key.



Football's rich list 2024

HERE'S is a record amount of money sloshing around in football at the moment and famous clubs from the Premier League, Ligue 1, La Liga and Bundesliga are among the most valuable in the world.

It will come as no surprise to learn that the Premier League dominates the top 10, with each of the traditional top six making an appearance in the table that matters most to assorted executives and chairman.

Here are the 10 most valuable football clubs in the world as of 2024.

10. Arsenal - £2.6 billion

With another strong (if trophyless) season behind them, it's no surprise to see Arsenal make the top 10.

Mikel Arteta has assembled a young and talented squad that plays in front of sell-out crowds at the Emirates and returned to the Champions League last year after a sevenyear absence.

9. Chelsea – £3.13 billion

Chelsea are still one of the richest clubs in the world, but their revenue stream was hit by the absence of European football last year, with Tottenham overtaking them as London's most valuable club.

8. Tottenham – £3.2 billion

Having qualified for the Champions League in five of the last nine seasons and recently built a new state-of-the-art stadium that is used for multiple concerts and sporting events, Spurs comfortably sit alongside Europe's elite clubs.

7. PSG - £4.4 billion

There's rarely a dull moment with the French champions. While they continue to come unstuck in the Champions League, PSG still retain a seat at the top table despite missing out on a transfer fee for Kylian Mbappe.

6. Bayern Munich – £5 billion

In many ways, Bayern are run like the ideal football club. They rarely overextend themselves in the transfer market – except for Harry Kane last summer – and yet they regularly go deep in Europe and usually win the Bundesliga.

5. Manchester City – £5.1 billion

Failing in their Champions League defence last season was compensated by a fourth successive league title – but with Pep Guardiola entering the last year of his contract and those 115 charges, there could be clouds on the currently sunny horizon.

4. Liverpool - £5.37 billion

Liverpool dealt with Jurgen Klopp's shock departure by seamlessly appointing Arne Slot as his

replacement.

In many ways, the whole process was indicative of how the club is run, having assembled a brilliant squad and redeveloped Anfield significantly in recent years.

3. Barcelona - £5.6 billion

Despite the financial turmoil the club have been recently, Barcelona still rank as the third most valuable club in the world.

The club had to get creative with their finances two summers ago by pulling several financial levers and the registration of Dani Olmo remains a teeth-pulling process.

2. Manchester United – £6.55 billion

Not even the arrival of Sir Jim Ratcliffe has helped United overhaul Real Madrid as the most valuable club in world football.

They've still increased their value by £550 million from last year despite finishing eighth in the Premier League, with exciting plans to build a new stadium adjacent to Old Trafford and the desire to invest in younger players.

1. Real Madrid – £6.6 billion

Real Madrid, worth £6.6 billion, is top of the table for the third consecutive year and for the eighth time in the past 11 years.

Madrid generated the most revenue (£873 million) and generated success in La Liga and the Champions League too. The arrivals of Kylian Mbappe and Endrick won't hurt global shirt sales either. Despite its enormous value, you can't invest in Real Madrid as the team is owned by more than 90,000 club members. It's in marked contrast to the English game.
